When you buy from one of our 10 Habitat ReStores, 100% of proceeds support affordable housing through Habitat for Humanity.



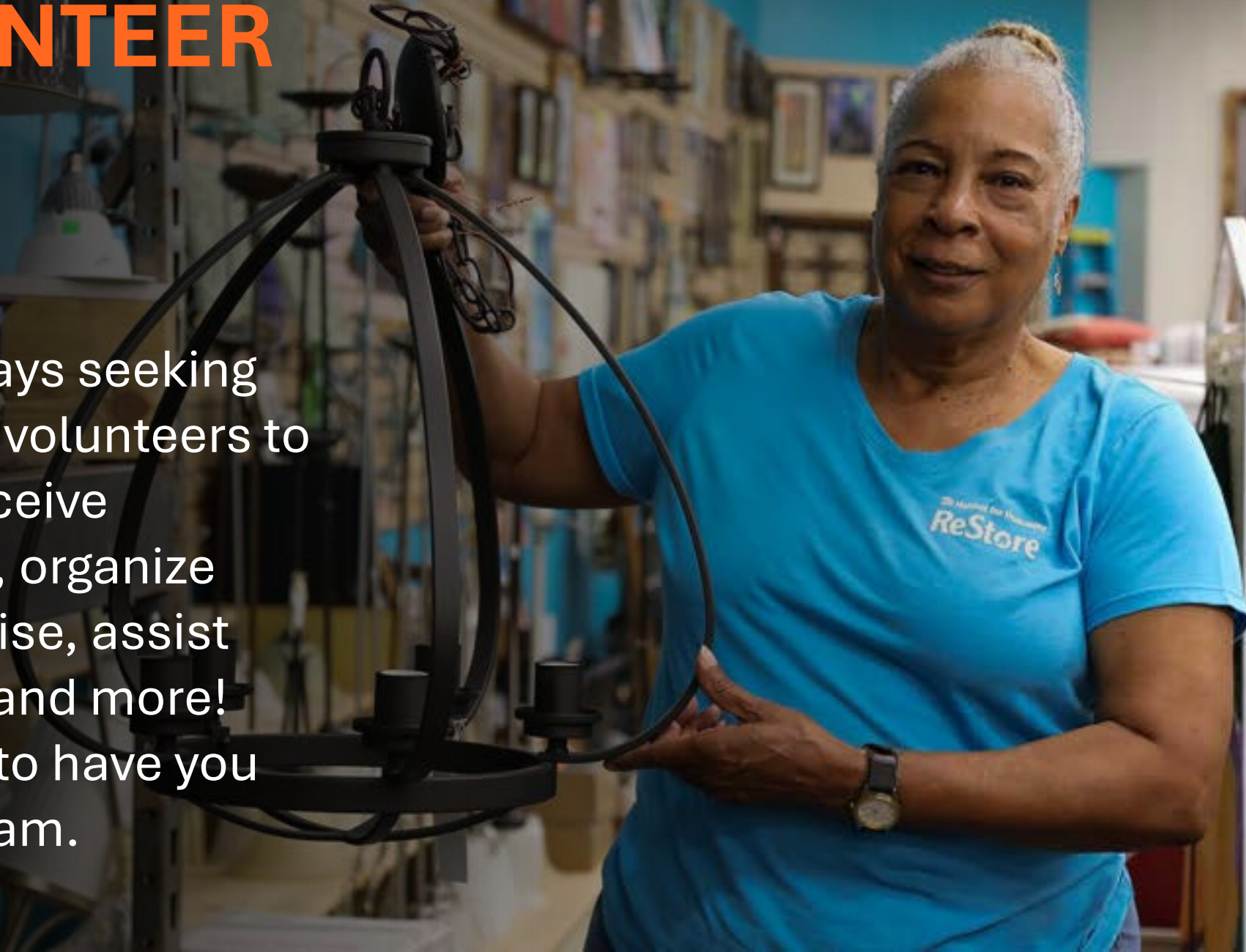

HOME PRESERVATION

Partner with homeowners who are not physically or financially able to make repairs. Tasks such as deck repairs, painting, ramp installations, and more help families stay in their homes.





Construction Requirements

You must be at least 16 years old to volunteer on site

You must be fully registered on Volunteer Hub (our online volunteer platform)

No construction experience is required!

We invite 2-3 key leaders to join the Kick-off ceremony. Afterwards, your volunteers will either work at Hope Grove or go to the construction warehouse for a wall build



Youth Initiative

- Encourage individuals to make a financial contribution (this can be credited to your congregation)



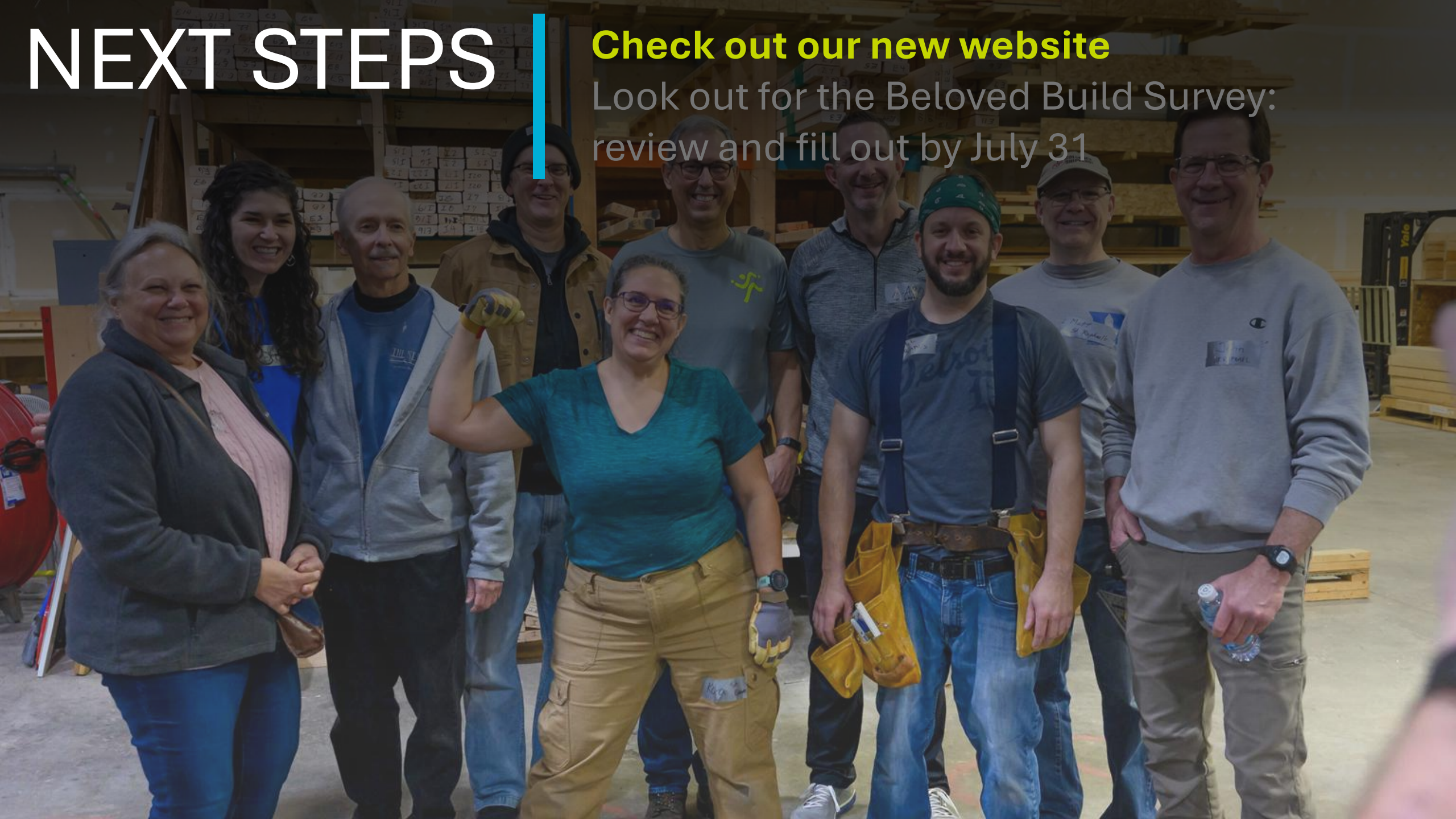
UPDATE: No Lunches
